SAFE SCALE is power packed. It dissolves the carbonates which hold scale and other deposits together. After the carbonates are dissolved, the sulfates, iron, calcium (lime), magnesium, and other insoluble materials fall away.

SAFE SCALE is safe. It may be used in all firetube, watertube, hot water boilers and cooling towers. If used as directed, it is safe to use on painted surfaces, finishes and metals.

DIRECTIONS

Dilute SAFE SCALE at a ratio of 4 parts water to 1 part SAFE SCALE. Apply with trigger sprayer or sponge on area you wish to remove unwanted scale. Allow to stand for 3 to 5 minutes, then wipe clean, then rinse with potable water. Repeated applications may be needed for extremely heavy scale deposits.
